The Executive Committee is a Statutory Committee as defined in the Health Professions Procedural Code (Schedule 2 of the RHPA, 1991).

Since June 16, 2022, the Committee has met twice.

On September 13, 2022, the Committee received a presentation outlining registrant statistics, including reported hours worked each year. A strategic plan to increase recruitment and retention via rebranding the College, and by extension, the profession, was outlined. The Committee agreed that the plan should be further developed and presented to Council. Financial projections were considered, as was an overview of the planning process. The Committee agreed to recommend that the same KRAs be maintained until the 2025 fiscal year.

At its September 23, 2022 meeting, the Committee accepted the audited financial statements for the 2021-2022 fiscal year. Discussion continued on options to address financial challenges. Recommendations included implementing a fee for credit card and installment payments, as well as a fee increase in keeping with bylaw 19.05. These recommendations will be further explored and considered by Council on October 6.
